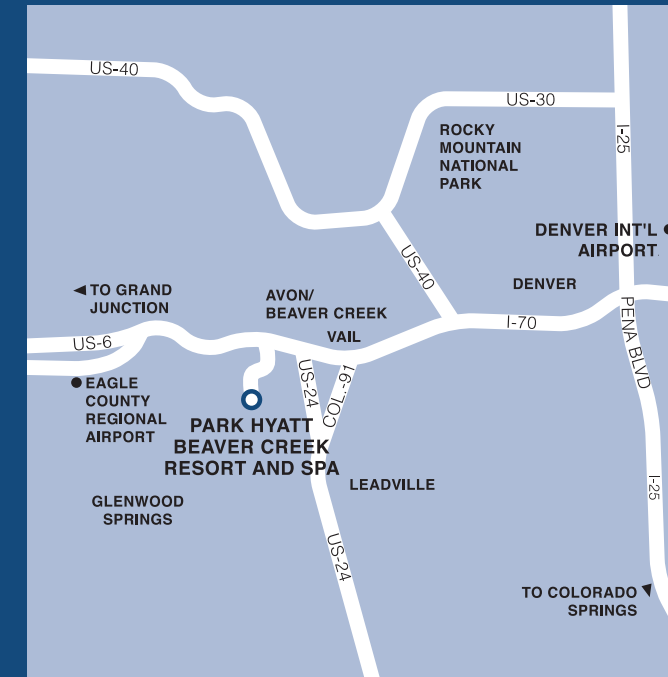
- Ski-in/ski-out access to Beaver Creek Mountain

- Beaver Creek has a mild climate with cool, dry summers and winters that boast record snowfalls, bringing fresh, light "powder" to the slopes. Average temperatures vary from -6.67°C - 12.78°C/20°F - 55°F during ski season to 18.33°C - 29.44°C/65°F - 85°F from June through August.
